Guidelines for Play Submission to Theatre Calgary's Literary Department (TC Lit D)

What's eligible?

Theatre Calgary prioritizes submissions from Canadian playwrights and/or playwrights residing in Canada. However, we are not limited to Canadian content and/or creators. We are particularly interested in hearing from under-represented communities.

What do we produce?

Theatre Calgary produces a subscription season of 6 to 8 full-length plays or musicals in English for multigenerational audiences. Our mandate is to stimulate, provoke, and delight through ambitious programming created to ignite local, national, and international engagement; to stand amongst the best theatres globally as a leader in innovation, impactful, and diverse programming.

What are the guidelines for script sample submissions?

Please send samples for consideration to Theatre Calgary's Literary Department at submissions@theatrecalgary.com. Please include the following in your proposal:

- A short synopsis
- A 20-page sample (including context if the pages are pulled from the middle of the script)
- Information about the development or production history of your play
- Play length
- A cast breakdown
- Why is this script a good fit for Theatre Calgary?
- Your full mailing address, phone number, and e-mail.

How do we respond?

Even with our 10-sample quota* per month, we still receive a lot of submissions. We want to let you know our capacity for response and put the following conditions in place:

- Script reading time varies over the course of a year and therefore it may be many months before you hear back from us. But you will hear back.
- We do not provide feedback as to why a script is not in contention for production, nor do we
 offer dramaturgical input.
- If your proposal is of interest, the playwright will be invited to send the full script and open a dialogue with us about next stages.
